

Suzette DeBoard: \$143.66 to build a collaborative weaving with preschool and Special Ed. classes to display in shared hallway for all to see. Money is for chicken wire and various ribbons for the project.

Richa Perkins: \$219.14 is for a listening station with head phones for students to listen to and draw what inspires them at the time.
